

Led to meaningful discussions in the FEHDI work

Parents had to find us in order to utilize our services

Outreach

Had to consistently reach out to providers and share about our program

After direct referrals

One-on-one support

Matched with a Parent Guide, limited time of 6 months

Opt out

All confirmed hearing losses get referred to our program

Outreach

Put on pause

 - Limited access to the EHDI-IS








After direct referrals: July 2020-June 2021








Age of Infant at GBYS Referral





EQUAL ACCESS GEOGRAPHICALLY








RACIAL EQUITY



Percent Increase of Infant Racial Diversity of Infants Enrolled in GBYS






AFTER REFERRALS









EQUALITY AFTER DIAGNOSIS

Enrolled - Have an active IFSP with EI


Not enrolled - Not connected with EI

GBYS Enrollment: Early Intervention Status Change



Reaching families earlier than ever. No infants after referrals were aged out of Early Intervention by the time of GBYS enrollment.

The majority, 76%, of infants enrolled in GBYS were either pending or not enrolled in Early

Intervention.




2021 Percentage of Successful Family Contact by Transition Specialist per Month
